Early Junior Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between Jan. 1st & Feb. 28th previous year.
Senior Yearling Heifer.....	Calved between Sept. 1st & Dec. 31st two years ago.
Junior Champion Female.....	First Prize Females from Early Summer Yearling Heifer; Late Summer Yearling Heifer; Senior Heifer and Junior Heifer Calf Classes
Senior Champion Female.....	First Prize Females from Senior Yearling Heifer; Early Junior Yearling & Late Junior Heifer Classes
Two Females.....	From above classes, owned by exhibitor
Three Females.....	From above classes, owned by exhibitor
Pair of Yearlings.....	Bull calved between Jan. 1st & Aug. 31st previous year and Jr. or Summer Yearling Heifer owned by exhibitor
Pair of Calves.....	Bull calved after Sept. 1st previous year & one Senior or Junior Heifer calf, owned by exhibitor
Best 3 Head.....	Both sexes represented, owned by exhibitor

Judging - Wednesday, at 1:00 p.m.

Entry Fee - \$25.00 (Includes \$10.00 processing fee) per animal entered if made by posted entry deadline date (This includes (1) Exhibitor Pass, does not include stall fee)

Late Processing Fee - additional \$10 per animal up until scale closes - Show Day at 10 a.m. Cattle released at end of show if not entered in Jr or 4-H Shows.

SHOW RULES

1. All cattle must meet current Exhibition Livestock Health Requirements.
2. Weigh-in time: 6-9 p.m., Tues., 8-10 a.m., Wed.
3. Registration papers (for breeds) will be furnished at weigh-in time.
4. No Cattle will be allowed to show (regardless of birthdate) that does not have all of its milk teeth showing, or evidence thereof. No stomach pumps.
5. Fresh tattoos are not allowed.
6. Cattle will show Angus, Hereford, Shorthorn, Simmentals, AOB, Crossbreds & MKT Heifer.
7. Cattle will be divided into weight classes by superintendents and approved by office.
8. If there are not at least 5 entries for a breed, they will show as all other breeds.
9. Cattle must weigh at least 1,000 pounds.

Classes may not be shown in order listed in book.

READ ALL RULES for exhibiting at this fair in front of book.

Market heifer can not be double exhibited in breeding classes.

The top 3 in each breed will be eligible for top 5 overall

GENERAL RULES

Section 260.95 Junior Class

Junior classes are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) shown in junior classes must be the property of the boys and girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and junior classes, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name. Any animals shown in purebred class must have registration papers on hand during fair.

Exhibitors may be assisted in herd or flock classes during the judging process only by other boys and girls who meet the age requirement set forth in section above.

1. READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of book, as these rules also apply to Junior Exhibitors.
2. Animals NOT entered in Open Classes will pay same stall or pen rent as corresponding class of open department.
3. Exhibitors may enter as many animals or exhibits as desired; however only two (2) premiums will be awarded to any individual in any one lot number entered.
4. If a Junior exhibitor is unable to show his exhibit, another Junior exhibitor may be secured to help. No adults!
5. All entries in breeding classes must be accompanied by registration papers from recognized record associations of their respective breed, showing the entry to be the property of the exhibitor only and registered to the Exhibitor.
6. Certificates from breed association representatives will not be accepted in lieu of registration papers.
7. Photo copies of registration papers not acceptable.
8. Any boy or girl showing an animal in Junior Show must be able to show ownership and effective rates for ownership must appear on the registration papers. Dates for required ownership are:

- Beef Steers must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Beef Purebred Heifers and Heifer Calves must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Beef females in cow performance class must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Calves and Heifers must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Aged Dairy Cows must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Milking Does must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Kids and Yearlings not in milk must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Swine must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Ram Lambs must have been lamed the property of the exhibitor after Sept. 1st of previous year.
- Ewe Lambs must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Yearlings Ewes must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Equine must have been owned since May 1st of current year.

9. All livestock must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. Wednesday and will be released at 7:30 p.m. Sunday. No livestock stalled before Tuesday 7:00 a.m.

- ~ A classification committee will be designated to inspect and determine final breed of animals, if disqualified, animal will show as commercial (if female) or crossbreed (if steer).
- ~ **Classes may not be shown in order listed in book.**
- ~ Market Heifer cannot be double exhibited in breeding classes.
