

TRAILER RACE RULES

Wednesday, 7:00PM

1. GENERAL EVENT DESCRIPTION

The intent of this event is good, cheap, fun competition. Competitors making it more than that by spending undue and unnecessary amounts of time and/or money on vehicle preparation will be discouraged from competing.

2. VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY SPECIFICATIONS

Kankakee County Fair Officials will determine whether a vehicle meets the applicable specifications for the Event. Only vehicles determined to meet the applicable specifications are eligible to compete in the Event.

3. COMPETITOR OBLIGATIONS AND PRIOR EVENT INSPECTION

If a Kankakee County Fair Official determines prior to the event that the ENTRY does not meet the applicable specifications, the ENTRY will not be allowed to compete unless, in the discretion of the Official the deficiency WILL NOT adversely affect the orderly conduct or safety of the event. Pit Gate closes to entrants promptly at 5:00 p.m. day of show.

4. DRIVER RESPONSIBILITIES

Drivers must be at least 18 years of age.

All drivers MUST attend the pre-event drivers meeting at 6:15 day of show. A thorough explanation of Event rules will be made. DRIVER ATTENDANCE AT THESE MEETING(S) AND COMPLIANCE WITH ALL RULES IS ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY.

5. TRAILER RACE REQUIREMENTS

Any full size tow vehicles will be approved, cars, ¾ ton or less pick-up trucks, vans etc...NO CONVERTIBLES OR FOUR WHEEL DRIVES (drive shaft must be removed if 4-Wheel Drive).

Tow vehicles must be stripped of all glass except windshields may stay.

All exterior lights, body moldings, plastic bumpers, valances, exterior mirrors, grills etc.... must be removed prior to arrival at fairgrounds!!!!

Batteries must remain in stock location and be securely fastened and covered.

All parts must be factory stock for that year, make and model.

NO lift kits or suspension alterations allowed.

NO reinforcing allowed except to front of car for radiator protection.

Driver door must be welded or wired shut (#9 Wire or larger).

Roll Cage or Roll Protection is Highly Recommended.

Tow Vehicle must display a one or two digit number the full height of the door on each side of the vehicle for identification purposes.

NO foam filled tires allowed.

NO AIR BAGS...If vehicle has an air bag it must be disconnected and ripped out.

6. DRIVER PROTECTION

Helmets with face shields and eye protection, leather gloves and footwear are mandatory. Fire suits HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. **SEATBELTS ARE MANDATORY.**

7. TRAILER HITCH

Standard receiver / stinger / ball set up (No Pin or Pintle Hitches allowed) may be attached to the tow vehicle by directly welding or mechanically fastening (bolting) to the frame of bumper.

A standard ball may be directly welded to the bumper of the tow vehicle. Trailer will be required to detach from the tow vehicle at the request of officials. Pintle hitches will NOT be allowed. **ABSOLUTELY NO SAFETY CHAINS ALLOWED.**

8. TRAILERS

NO HANDMADE TRAILERS ALLOWED.

Any type of trailer is permitted, however open flatbed trailers must be loaded. No excessive screws or nails can be used. Be creative, themes are what makes this a fun event. No aluminum boats allowed. Basically, whatever can fall off the trailer must break apart when hit by the pull vehicles. Relief cuts should be made in boats, campers, etc. so as when hit they will easily break apart upon impact and all interiors must be completely stripped inside (i.e...No windows, toilets, sinks, trash, beds etc...). Absolutely no hay, straw or other highly flammable materials allowed on trailer. Promoter discretion will be final.

9. EVENT RULES

Any time a tow vehicle becomes separated from trailer that vehicle will be deemed unable to compete for the remainder of event.

Trailer (frame) must remain intact from hitch through and including at least 6' of tongue or it will be deemed unable to compete for the remainder of event.

Do not leave cockpit of tow vehicle until event ends, unless on fire or instructed to do so by track official. Keep seat belts and helmets on at all times.

Object of competition is to dislodge trailer from the other competitors. ANY CONTACT WITH THE TOW/PULL VEHICLE DURING THE RACE MAY CAUSE DISQUALIFICATION.

ANY COMPETITOR HITTING THE TOW VEHICLE ON PURPOSE WILL BE BLACK FLAGGED!

Participants merely racing around the track trying to avoid contact of making contact will be disqualified....Remember the fans are looking for a show of destruction.

Event winner will be the last vehicle running with tow trailer (no less than 3' – 4' of tongue) still attached.

10. ENTRY FEE/PRIZE MONEY

NO entry fee. Entry form **MUST** be completed and received by Kankakee County Fair Official no later than 5:00 P.M. as entries close! Participants must be in the pits and ready to compete by 5:00 P.M. NO EXCEPTIONS INCLUDING COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS. Driver meeting will be at 6:15 P.M. before start of event.

BEST DESIGN OF SHOW - \$100.00 (Picked by Fans in Grandstand)

EVENT PAYOUT: 1ST \$750.00, 2ND \$500.00 3RD \$250.00 OTHER PARTICIPANTS RECEIVE \$100.00 (Must hit to receive)
