

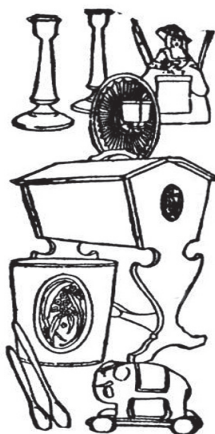
**ADDITIONAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

**THESE RULES ARE IN ADDITION TO
GENERAL RULES IN THIS BOOK!**

1. READ General Rules in front of this book! All rules apply to this department.
2. Articles for exhibition in the Creative Arts Building will be accepted between 3 p.m. and 7 p.m. on the Tuesday before start of fair on Wednesday.
3. Any one article may not be entered in more than one classification.
4. Any article entered will be judged according to quality.
5. Blue Ribbons are designated for first premium, red ribbons for second premium, white ribbons for third premium and Royal Blue Rosettes for Championships.
6. Creative Arts Building will close doors at 6:30 p.m., on Sunday the last day the advertised fair to prepare for release time. Articles can be picked up at 7 p.m. on Sunday evening or Monday from 9-10 a.m. in accordance with rules and regulations covering State Aid to County Fairs.
7. Ticket stubs must be presented when articles are picked up from the Creative Arts Building. NO EXCEPTIONS!
8. Creative Arts Building will be closed on the day of judging until 1:00 p.m.
9. All articles must be exhibited by the person who made and/or grew the product.

GENERAL RULES

Section 260.95 Junior Class

Junior classes are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) shown in junior classes must be the property of the boys and girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and junior classes, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name. Any animals shown in purebred class must have registration papers on hand during fair.

Exhibitors may be assisted in herd or flock classes during the judging process only by other boys and girls who meet the age requirement set forth in section above.

1. READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of book, as these rules also apply to Junior Exhibitors.
2. Animals NOT entered in Open Classes will pay same stall or pen rent as corresponding class of open department.
3. Exhibitors may enter as many animals or exhibits as desired; however only two (2) premiums will be awarded to any individual in any one lot number entered.
4. If a Junior exhibitor is unable to show his exhibit, another Junior exhibitor may be secured to help. No adults!
5. All entries in breeding classes must be accompanied by registration papers from recognized record associations of their respective breed, showing the entry to be the property of the exhibitor only and registered to the Exhibitor.
6. Certificates from breed association representatives will not be accepted in lieu of registration papers.
7. Photo copies of registration papers not acceptable.
8. Any boy or girl showing an animal in Junior Show must be able to show ownership and effective rates for ownership must appear on the registration papers. Dates for required ownership are:

- Beef Steers must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Beef Purebred Heifers and Heifer Calves must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Beef females in cow performance class must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Calves and Heifers must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Aged Dairy Cows must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Milking Does must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Kids and Yearlings not in milk must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Swine must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Ram Lambs must have been lamed the property of the exhibitor after Sept. 1st of previous year.
- Ewe Lambs must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Yearlings Ewes must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Equine must have been owned since May 1st of current year.

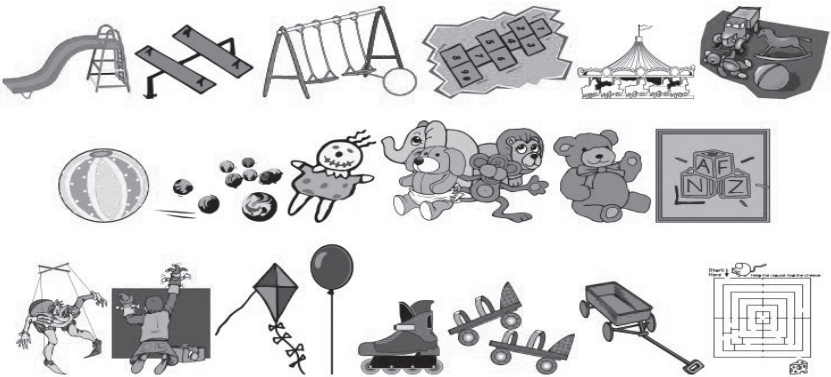
