READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of this book.

- ~ All Swine must meet Exhibition Livestock Health requirements.
- ~ All animals shown must be plainly ear notched. Fresh Ear Notches are not allowed. All animals must be accompanied with valid Breed Association registration papers in the farm or individual's name. (No exceptions)
- ~ **Concerning Premiums**, single barrows in purebred classes (A,D,E,G) split into two (2) weight classes will pay out five (5) places; other single purebred classes (B,C,F) split into three (3) weight classes will pay out five (5) places; Market Gilts will split into a maximum of seven (7) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places; Crossbred Barrows will split into a maximum of ten (10) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places.
- ~ Market swine must be weighed and numbered Wednesday evening before 8p.m. (NO WEIGHING WILL BE DONE ON THURSDAY MORNING). All animals will weigh between 210 lbs and 285 lbs then all weights will be divided as even as possible by computer.
- ~ All swine must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. Wednesday and will be released at 7:30 p.m. Sunday.
- ~ ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING.
- ~ No oil, powder or hair coatings may be used to dress hog for the show. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE IS CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION.

GENERAL RULES

Section 260.95 Junior Class

Junior classes are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in the third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair. All animals (i.e., individual, herd or flock classes) shown in junior classes must be the property of the boys and girls showing them. If the same animals are shown in both the open classes and junior classes, they shall be shown under the same exhibitor's name. Any animals shown in purebred class must have registration papers on hand during fair.

Exhibitors may be assisted in herd or flock classes during the judging process only by other boys and girls who meet the age requirement set forth in section above.

1. READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of book, as these rules also apply to Junior Exhibitors.
2. Animals NOT entered in Open Classes will pay same stall or pen rent as corresponding class of open department.
3. Exhibitors may enter as many animals or exhibits as desired; however only two (2) premiums will be awarded to any individual in any one lot number entered.
4. If a Junior exhibitor is unable to show his exhibit, another Junior exhibitor may be secured to help. No adults!
5. All entries in breeding classes must be accompanied by registration papers from recognized record associations of their respective breed, showing the entry to be the property of the exhibitor only and registered to the Exhibitor.
6. Certificates from breed association representatives will not be accepted in lieu of registration papers.
7. Photo copies of registration papers not acceptable.
8. Any boy or girl showing an animal in Junior Show must be able to show ownership and effective rates for ownership must appear on the registration papers. Dates for required ownership are:

- Beef Steers must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Beef Purebred Heifers and Heifer Calves must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Beef females in cow performance class must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Calves and Heifers must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Aged Dairy Cows must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Milking Does must have been owned since January 1st of current year.
- Dairy Goat Kids and Yearlings not in milk must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Swine must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Ram Lambs must have been lamed the property of the exhibitor after Sept. 1st of previous year.
- Ewe Lambs must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Yearlings Ewes must have been owned since June 1st of current year.
- Equine must have been owned since May 1st of current year.

9. All livestock must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. Wednesday and will be released at 7:30 p.m. Sunday. No livestock stalled before Tuesday 7:00 a.m.

READ General Rules for Junior Department governing exhibits in this section.

All Swine entered in this section (except crossbred) must be purebred.

All animals must be accompanied with valid Breed Association registration papers in the farm name or individual. (No exceptions).

All animals shown must be plainly ear notched. FRESH EAR NOTCHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.

These ear notches will be inspected to determine if they agree with those recorded on the registration papers of the animals exhibited.

All litters must have been farrowed the property of the exhibitor.

Concerning premiums, single barrows in purebred classes (AA,DD,EE, GG) split into two (2) weight classes will pay out five (5) places; other single purebred classes (BB,CC,FF) split into three (3) weight classes will pay out five (5) places; Market Gilts will split into a maximum of seven (7) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places; Crossbred Barrows will split into a maximum of ten (10) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places.

This is a TESTED Split Show. All animals must be tested. All Swine must be stalled by 7:00 a.m.

Wednesday and will be released Sunday at 7:30 p.m. Market Swine must be weighted and numbered Wednesday evening before 8:00 p.m. (NO WEIGHING WILL BE DONE ON THURSDAY MORNING). All animals will weigh between 210-285 lbs. then all weights will be divided as even as possible by computer.

ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING.

All Swine exhibited in this department must have been farrowed on or after January 1, of current year.

A litter shall consist of three head farrowed after January 1, current year, consisting of three gilts or two gilts and one barrow. This is to be the produce of one sow.
