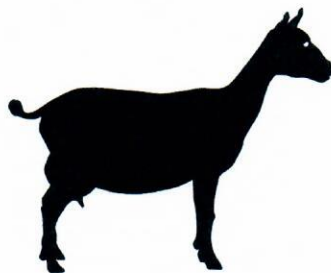
All goats must be in place by 7:00 a.m. Wednesday opening day of fair and will be released at 8:00 p.m. Sunday or when announced by Fair President.

- ~All market goats will weigh-in on Wednesday between 9am – 10am
- ~Market animals cannot be entered in registered classes.
- ~All goats must meet current Exhibition Livestock Health Requirements.
- ~No entries accepted day of show.
- ~All rules governing exhibition, judging, and awarding of prizes will be interpreted by the Superintendent (s) of show.
- ~All animals must be accompanied by registration papers (no photocopies accepted) and all animals must have current Health Papers upon arrival for inspection.
- ~Registration numbers and tattoo numbers must be listed on entry blank, and all goats will be ear tag or tattoo number validated. Tattoos must be healed and legible.
- ~All animals to be exhibited in the Breeding Classes are to be purebred and registered in recognized record association of their respective breed.
- ~Due to sanitary conditions, NO goat milk will be dumped on the ground. Take it home or dump it in a drum by barn. Failure to comply with this rule will result in premiums being forfeited.
