READ General Rules for Junior Department governing exhibits in this section.

All Swine entered in this section (except crossbred must be purebred.

All animals must be accompanied with valid Breed Association registration papers in the farm name or individual. (No exceptions).

All animals shown must be plainly ear notched. FRESH EAR NOTCHES ARE NOT ALLOWED.

These ear notches will be inspected to determine if they agree with those recorded on the registration papers of the animals exhibited.

Concerning premiums, single barrows in purebred classes split into **two (2)** weight classes will pay out five (5) places; Market Gilts will split into a maximum of **four (4)** weight classes and pay out eight (8) places; Crossbred Barrows will split into a maximum of **seven (7)** weight classes and pay out eight (8) places.

This is a TESTED Split Show. All animals must be tested. All Swine must be stalled by 7:00 a.m.

Wednesday and will be released Sunday at 8:00 p.m. Market Swine must be weighed and numbered Wednesday evening between 5 pm - 7 pm.

All animals will then be divided by weight.

**ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING**

All Swine exhibited in this department must have been farrowed on or after January 1, of the current year. No boars.

READ General Rules for exhibiting at this Fair in front of this book.

~All swine must meet Exhibition Livestock Health requirements.

~All animals shown must be plainly ear notched. Fresh Ear Notches are not allowed. All animals must be accompanied with valid Breed Association registration papers in the farm or individual's name. (No exceptions) **\*\*All swine exhibited at Illinois county fairs will be required to have an electronic 840 tag. \*\*\*NEW FOR 2025**

~**Concerning Premiums**, single barrows in purebred classes split into two (2) weight classes will pay out five (5) places; Market Gilts will split into a maximum of six (6) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places; Crossbred Barrows will split into a maximum of seven (7) weight classes and pay out eight (8) places.

~Market swine must be weighed and numbered Wednesday 5:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. All weights will then be divided into classes.

~All swine must be stalled by 7:00 a.m. Wednesday and will be released at 8:00 p.m. Sunday or when Fair President announces their release.

~ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING.

~No oil, powder or hair coatings may be used to dress hogs for the show. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE IS CAUSE FOR DISQUALIFICATION.

~FUTURES SHOW – Open to exhibitor too young to enter in JR. Show and has posted an entry in Open Show, Thursday 6:00 p.m.

~Peewee Showmanship – Any child may borrow an entered pig and have opportunity to show – Friday following Open Show.

### Age classification and group requirements are as follows:

December or Senior.....	Farrowed between Dec. 1 & Dec. 31 of last year
January or Senior.....	Farrowed between Jan. 1 & Jan. 31 of current year
February or Junior.....	Farrowed between Feb. 1 & Feb. 29 of current year
March or Junior.....	Farrowed between Mar. 1 & Mar. 31 of current year
